Retirement Notice

Art Park Amphitheater Project

The Art Park Amphitheater Project is finishing up! The Grand Opening is scheduled for Thursday, May 22 at 6:00pm. We hope Advisory Board Members are able to attend the ribbon cutting ceremony. The evening will include live entertainment, food trucks, and activities for kids.

Robinette Park Renovation Project

Robinette Park Playground Installation is underway and should be completed the first week of May. The playground turf installers will then mobilize and complete the turf install. This should take 1-2 weeks. If the weather cooperates, we are anticipating the playground being ready for play around May 19. We are planning a Grand Opening of the playground and will notify Park Board Members once a date is in place.


PARKS

- Walkway leveling was completed at the VRC, Sports Complex, Senior Center, Justice Center, and Municipal Building.
 Uneven areas were removed to provide a safer walkway.
- Staff poured five concrete trashcan bases that will be installed at the Art Park. Staff also installed a catch basin and drainage tile at the Art Park to eliminate any water ponding issues along the east pathway area.
- The asphalt contractor is laying the new asphalt at the Art Park. After some additional soil and seeding work, their site work will be complete.
- Cemetery work is being completed, including low grave soil maintenance and grass seed application.
- Preparations and set up for Easter Eggstravaganza Event.
- Issues with the underground electrical wiring at the Sports Complex occurred after a heavy rain event, and continued for about a week. Robert Martin with DES will be testing some of the equipment in the Park electrical room with the aid of a Contractor. The issues have not been rectified, but the ground has dried out enough that the problems are not currently occurring.
- Robinette Park play structure install is well under way.
- 20 of the 22 garden plots have been reserved at Jeffers Park.
- Cassel Hills Pool work is well under way. Staff and our contractor are working to get the pool ready for the season.
- Replacement seating benches were installed at the VRC, Sports Complex, and Cassel Hill Pool.

TREE CITY USA / URBAN FOREST

- Tree Planting Replacement trees are in place along National Road and Perry Street. Princeton Sentry Ginkgo (17) and Lucas Hornbeam (26).
- Commemorative Tree planting at the Sports Complex, Seger Park, Art Park, and Robinette Park. A total of 11 trees
 were planted, and included Wright Brothers Sugar Maple, Rogers Lustre Serviceberry, Shumard Oak, Early Glow
 Ohio Buckeye, and Green Mountain Sugar Maple.
- Our Arbor Day Event will be held on Friday, April 25, at 10:00am at Morton Middle School. We will pass out 300 bareroot Redbud seedlings to the 6th graders. This year's Arbor Day Tree, that will be planted at the Event, is a Crimson Sunset Maple.

RECREATION CENTER

- The Vandalia Parks and Recreation Department was awarded a grant from the Dayton Foundation for \$3,650 to
 purchase supplies for a Mobile Sensory Tent. This tent area will be for those with sensory sensitivities and will be
 available at special events and recreation initiatives.
- Recreation Superintendent Alicia McCracken and Facilities Superintendent Rudy Wells worked with a local Girl Scout Troop to add a Kindness Rock Garden to Art Park. It is located at the front of the Park by the brain sculpture.





ATHLETICS

- Baseball/Softball Opening Day is Saturday, April 26. A total of 435 kids are in the program, up 30 kids over last year.
- Adult Softball Leagues will begin in early May. We have 16 teams for the Men's Monday League, and 6 teams for the Coed Friday League.
- Fall athletics registration opened on Wednesday, April 2. To date, 25 kids are enrolled in soccer, and 7 kids are enrolled in flag football.
- Flyers to the school will go out soon for Fall Programs, as we want to market before school is out for summer break.
- New Adult Softball League Supervisor will be Jeff Chrisman.
- Greg Justice, our Umpire Assigner, held an Umpire Training on Sunday, April 13. 25 potential umpires attended.

Completed Events

- Adult Easter Egg Hunt was held on Friday, April 11, at 8:00pm. Eggs contained candy, gift cards/coupons, and raffle tickets. After the hunt was over, everyone met back in the VRC Gymnasium to count eggs and begin the raffle. We had over 25 raffle prizes for this event, and 80 gift cards/coupons. 102 participants registered for this program!
- **Underwater Egg Hunt** was held on Saturday, April 12, at 10:00am for children ages 3-12 years old. Eggs were hidden at the bottom of the pool and participants were able to turn in their eggs for candy and prizes. Four lucky golden egg winners also received special Easter baskets! We had 59 registered participants for this program.
- Skyhawks Beginning Golf, run by Skyhawks Staff, is running a 4-session program at the Sports Complex, beginning Wednesday, April 16. The program uses a fun, games-based approach to engage young golfers! Specialized equipment is used to provide early success for young players, while also helping them develop key skills. This program has 18 participants registered.
- **Homeschool Takeover** was held on Friday, April 18, from 11:30am-2:00pm. Homeschool groups and families enjoyed everything the VRC has to offer; swimming, climbing wall, gym activities, and Luther's Jungle. We had 40 families/groups attend, with a total of 190 participants.
- Easter Eggstravaganza was held on Saturday, April 19, at the Sports Complex from 11:00am to 2:00pm, with over 1,000 attendees. The event featured two egg hunts at 11:00am and 12:30pm for children ages 12 and under.
