RESOLUTION 18-R-69

AN ORDINANCE REZONING THE PROPERTY GENERALLY LOCATED AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF MILLER LANE AND STOP EIGHT ROAD FROM RESIDENTIAL SINGLE-FAMILY 1 “RSF-1” TO HIGHWAY BUSINESS “HB” AND AMENDING THE ZONING MAP OF THE CITY

It rezones the property generally located at the northwest corner of Miller Lane and Stop Eight Road from Residential Single-Family 1 “RSF-1” to Highway Business “HB” and amending the zoning map of the city.
