RESOLUTION 17-R-04

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A TORO GROUNDSMASTER 4000-D, REQUESTED BY THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT, FROM CENTURY EQUIPMENT OF CINCINNATI AT THE STATE OF OHIO CONTRACT BID PRICE OF \$57,718.81 AND REQUESTING COUNCIL DECLARE THE CURRENT 2005 TORO ROUGH MOWER 4000-D BEING REPLACED SURPLUS PROPERTY

The resolution, which bears the foregoing title, was unanimously adopted on Tuesday, January 17, 2017 by the Council of the City of Vandalia.
