RESOLUTION 16-R-89

A RESOLUTION AWARDING THE BID FOR THE PURCHASE OF A PORTABLE AIR COMPRESSOR, REQUESTED BY THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, TO OHIO CAT, AT THE LOWEST AND BEST BID PRICE OF \$22,650.00 AND DECLARING THE EXISTING AIR COMPRESSOR SURPLUS PROPERTY

The resolution, which bears the foregoing title, was unanimously adopted on Monday, November 7, 2016 by the Council of the City of Vandalia. It awards the bid for the purchase of a portable air compressor, requested by the Public Works Department, to Ohio Cat, at the lowest and best bid price of \$22,650.00 and declares the existing air compressor surplus property. A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL TRAFFIC ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE EVALUATION OF SEMI-TRUCK TRAFFIC ON US-40 IN VANDALIA FROM THE AIRPORT ACCESS ROAD TO I-75 WITH LJB, INC., AS REQUESTED BY THE DEVELOPMENT AND ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT AS THE BEST PROPOSAL IN THE AMOUNT OF \$17,970 AS SUBMITTED WITH THEIR STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS
