RESOLUTION 16-R-73

A RESOLUTION AWARDING THE BID FOR THE DUMP BODY & HYDRAULIC EQUIPMENT FOR A ONE TON TRUCK, REQUESTED BY THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, TO JW DEVERS & SON, INC., AT THE LOWEST AND BEST BID PRICE OF \$24,590.00 AND DECLARING THE EXISTING DUMP BODY & HYDRAULIC EQUIPMENT SURPLUS PROPERTY
