RESOLUTION 16-R-15

A RESOLUTION AWARDING THE BID FOR ASPHALTIC CONCRETE, REQUESTED BY THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, TO VALLEY ASPHALT CORP. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$66.00/TON FOR TYPE II ASPHALT AND \$67.00/TON FOR TYPE I ASPHALT AS THE LOWEST AND BEST BID

The resolution, which bears the foregoing title, was unanimously adopted on Monday, March 7, 2016 by the Council of the City of Vandalia. A RESOLUTION WAIVING THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCESS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PACE ANALYTICAL SERVICES, INC TO PROVIDE EPA MANDATED SAMPLING AND TESTING OF SANITARY SEWER DISCHARGE FROM VARIOUS INDUSTRIES AND BACTERIA TESTING OF DRINKING WATER IN THE CITY OF VANDALIA FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2016

The resolution, which bears the foregoing title, was unanimously adopted on Monday, March 7, 2016 by the Council of the City of Vandalia. It waives the formal bidding process and authorizes the city manager to enter into a contract with Pace Analytical Services, Inc. to provide EPA mandated sampling and testing of sanitary sewer discharge from various industries and bacteria testing of drinking water in the city of Vandalia for the calendar year 2016. The resolution, which bears the foregoing title, was unanimously adopted on Monday, March 7, 2016 by the Council of the City of Vandalia. It waives the formal bidding process and authorizes the purchase of three cruiser in-car cameras, requested by the Division of Police, from CDW-Government Inc. at the National Joint Powers Alliance purchasing contract amount of \$10,344. ORDINANCE 16-02

AN ORDINANCE REZONING THE PROPERTY AT 131, 139 AND 209 S. DIXIE DRIVE FROM RESIDENTIAL MULTI-FAMILY “RMF” TO OFFICE/RESIDENTIAL “OR”; WITH A PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT (PUD) OVERLAY AND RE-PLATTING 1.164 ACRES OF SAID LAND WHICH INCLUDES 0.140 ACRES OF DEDICATED RIGHT OF WAY

The ordinance which bears the foregoing title was unanimously approved in its first reading Monday, March 7, 2016, by the Council of the City of Vandalia. It rezones the property at 131, 139 and 209 S. Dixie Drive from residential multi-family “RMF” to office/residential “OR”; with a planned unit development (PUD) overlay and re-platting 1.164 acres of said land which includes 0.140 acres of dedicated right of way. The proposed ordinance will be considered for final adoption by the Council of the City of Vandalia, Ohio on Monday, March 21, 2016 at 7:00 p.m., in Council Chambers, 333 J.E.
