

In an effort to increase awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the actions of the Vandalia City Council. We hope this promotes a better understanding of the role Council plays in keeping Vandalia a great place to live, work and play.

Council took the following actions at the Monday, February 15 meeting:

- Conducted the swearing in of Dan Wendt as City Manager.
- Directed the City Manager not to provide water service outside the corporate boundary of Vandalia for the Northpoint development along Dixie Drive.
- Approved Resolution 21-R-09 authorizing the agreement with Business First! through December 31, 2025. This program promotes communication and cooperation between economic development entities. The annual cost to participate in the program is \$1,500.
- Approved Resolution 21-R-10 authorizing an agreement with the Miami Valley Regional Crime Laboratory for the 2021 calendar year in the amount of \$25,351, an 8.5% decrease from the 2020 rate.
- Approved, in its second reading, Ordinance 21-03 rezoning 5.15 acres of land located at 675 Waldsmith Way from Residential Two-Family to Residential Single-Family 3.
- Approved, in its second reading, Ordinance 21-04 amending Section 678.09 and adding additional language that was inadvertently left out when the Ordinance was amended in 2019.
- Approved, as an emergency, Ordinance 21-05 to assess properties for delinquent accounts related to storm water fees, trash collection, property cleanup and weed/grass cutting. A vote by emergency was necessary in order to expedite the process of placing the assessments on the respective property tax bills.
