

In an effort to increase awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the actions of the Vandalia City Council. We hope this promotes a better understanding of the role Council plays in keeping Vandalia a great place to live, work and play.

Council took the following actions at the Tuesday, January 21 meeting:

- Adopted Resolution 20-R-02, approving an upgrade of the City's SAN Storage, which allows the city to locally host large amounts of data that is utilized by our servers and departments. In order to maintain interoperability with existing and new equipment, the IT Department recommended continuing with the same equipment (HP Enterprise) that we are currently utilizing. The IT Department has received a quote of \$139,989.98 from DTGi, a Vandalia based reseller. An additional \$4,500 in costs is estimated for connectors and adopter from various vendors.
- Approved, in its second reading, Ordinance 20-01 authorizing the rezoning of approximately 0.232-acres at 1 E. National Road from Office-Residential (OR) to Office Service (OS). The subject property totals of 0.723-acres, which is comprised of two different zoning classifications. The remaining 0.491-acres is already zoned Office-Service (OS). The purpose of the rezoning is to bring the entire lot under one zoning classification.
