

In an effort to increase awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the actions of the Vandalia City Council. We hope this promotes a better understanding of the role Council plays in keeping Vandalia a great place to live, work and play.

Council took the following actions at the Monday, December 16, 2019 meeting:



Mayor Setzer gave a proclamation to Councilman Gerhard honoring him for his 17 years of service as a City Councilman. Tuesday December 17, 2019 is Dave Gerhard day in the City of Vandalia.



Council adopted Resolution 19-R-59, authorizing a plat of 11.791 acres of land located at 3350 Benchwood Road. The plat created one 0.919-acre lot on Benchwood Road just west of the former IHOP site and one 10.873-acre lot for the New Life Worship Center. Additionally, 0.169-acres will be dedicated as public right-of-way on Benchwood Road.



Council gave second reading to Ordinance 19-31 rezoning 7.73 acres of land at 3350 Benchwood Road from Residential Single-Family 1 to Gateway Business. The subject property is part of the above replat that attached the 7.73-acre parcel to the existing New Life Worship Center lot. This rezoning would place all of the New Life Worship Center's property under the same Gateway Business zoning classification.



Council adopted, as an emergency, Ordinance 19-32, amending 2019 appropriations as follows:

General Fund - \$163,500

Council

- \$28,000 To account for additional expenses due to an adjustment to the OPERS withholding deduction for council members as a result of an audit by the State of Ohio.
- \$33,500 To account for additional expenses due to the increase in council wages and benefits.

Finance

• \$101,900 – To account for additional expenses due to the increase in the amount of refunds requested in the income tax division.

Fire

- \$7,500 To account for additional vehicle repair expenses in the Division of Fire.
- \$5,900 To account for additional gas and oil expenses

Computer Legal Research Fund - \$40,000

• \$40,000 – To account for expenses for a new court room sound system.



Council adopted, as an emergency, Ordinance 19-33 authorizing a lump sum bonus to be paid to the City Manager in the amount of \$3,000. This bonus is based upon the City Manager's performance.



Council adopted, as an emergency, Ordinance 19-34 assessing properties for delinquent accounts related to weed cutting, storm water, trash collection, sewer and water.
