

Council Action

In an effort to increase awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the actions of the Vandalia City Council. We hope this promotes a better understanding of the role Council plays in keeping Vandalia a great place to live, work and play.

Council took the following actions at the Monday, November 4 meeting:

- ✓ Approved the appointment of Mr. Taylor Cupp to the Vandalia Cultural Arts Committee
- ✓ Passed Resolution 19-R-56, approving the purchase of 6 portable vehicle lifts to replace the failing in-floor lift in the Public Works Garage. The vehicle lifts allow the City to service both passenger vehicles and larger vehicles, like the fire engines, ladder truck and tandem dump trucks, in house. The cost to purchase the lifts is \$66,712.96
- ✓ Approved in its second reading, Ordinance 19-20 for a Preliminary Plan for a mixed-use development at 7100 Webster Street. The 81-acre site is proposed to be developed with three subareas. Sub areas A & B, which front on Webster Street, are proposed for commercial and industrial uses. Sub area C, which is located to the rear of the property, is proposed for multi-family development. Sub area C is planned to be the first phase of development and would contain 173 units of multi-family housing. The type of housing ranges from 4-8 units per building. Each unit is proposed to include a 2-car attached garage, 2 bedrooms and 2 full baths. Each building would have a single-story design that is both ADA & FHA compliant.
- ✓ Approved as an emergency, Ordinance 19-21, to amend 2019 financial appropriations to add an additional \$66,900 for the purchase of six portable vehicle lifts for the Public Works Garage.
- ✓ Approved as an emergency, Ordinance 19-22, in order to assess properties for delinquent accounts related to storm water fees, trash collection, property clean up and weed cutting.
- ✓ Approved a variance request to permit an 8-foot-tall fence where 6-feet is the maximum height permitted on property located at 6300 Miller Lane.
