Council took the following actions at the Monday, March 1 meeting:

- Appointed Matthew Bauer to the Community Reinvestment Area Housing Council and to the Housing Board of Appeals.

- Approved Resolution 21-R-11 authorizing the purchase of body worn cameras, software and mounting equipment for the Vandalia Division of Police. The cost of this upgrade is \$60,025.30. The equipment being replaced was declared surplus property.

- Approved Resolution 21-R-12 amending the contract with Pickrel, Schaeffer, & Ebeling to allow for an increase in the hourly rate for legal direction from \$155/hr to \$162.50/hr in 2021 and a rate of \$170/hr for 2022.
