RESOLUTION 21-R-32

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE 2021 SLR 108 FOOT AERIAL LADDER FIRE TRUCK FROM SUTPHEN MANUFACTURING IN THE AMOUNT OF THE STATE BID PRICE OF \$1,134,311.86, PURCHASING ADDITIONAL LOOSE EQUIPMENT AND DECLARING THE 1996 AERIAL LADDER TRUCK BEING REPLACED SURPLUS PROPERTY

The resolution, which bears the foregoing title, was unanimously approved Monday, May 17, 2021, by the Council of the City of Vandalia. The resolution authorizes the purchase of one 2021 SLR 108 foot aerial ladder fire truck from Sutphen Manufacturing in the amount of the state bid price of \$1,134,311.86, purchasing additional loose equipment and declaring the 1996 aerial ladder truck being replaced surplus property. AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AND A RESOLUTION AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION AND PUBLICATION OF NEW MATTER IN THE UPDATED AND REVISED CODIFIED ORDINANCES; AND REPEALING ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

It approves individual assessments amounts and directs the Finance Director or her designee to certify the amounts to the County Auditor for collection and declaring an emergency.
