

In an effort to increase awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the actions of the Vandalia City Council. We hope this promotes a better understanding of the role Council plays in keeping Vandalia a great place to live, work and play.

## Council took the following actions at the Monday, October 4 meeting:

- Approved Resolution 21-R-63 awarding the bid for the replacement of a work van to Beau Townsend Ford. The 2022 Cargo Van with tool compartment package will replace a 1995 Chevrolet Astro Van for the Parks and Recreation Department. The 1995 Astro Van has been declared surplus and will be placed on GovDeals or otherwise disposed of by the City Manager as provided by law.
- Approved Resolution 21-R-64 authorizing the City Manager to enter into a project development agreement with Energy Systems Group (ESG) to perform a detailed engineering evaluation of City facilities to determine whether it can develop a viable project for contract consideration. If ESG's evaluation and cost estimate results in a viable project, the City intends to negotiate a Guaranteed Energy Savings Performance Contract under which ESG would design, install and implement cost-reducing strategies at an agreed upon financial cost.
