

In an effort to increase awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the actions of the Vandalia City Council. We hope this promotes a better understanding of the role Council plays in keeping Vandalia a great place to live, work and play.

Council took the following actions at the Monday, December 6 meeting:

- Approved Resolution 21-R-72 authorizing a donation of \$10,000 to the Vandalia Development Corporation. This donation supports a recent grant approval.
- Approved Resolution 21-R-73 authorizing the City Manager to enter into an agreement with Swim-Safe Pool Management to provide aquatic staffing at Cassel Hills Pool and the Vandalia Recreation Center.
- Approved Resolution 21-R-74 authorizing the City Manager to enter into a Parks & Recreation Master Plan Development agreement with PROS Consulting, Inc. for a cost not to exceed \$100,000. The Parks and Recreation Master Plan will explore best practices in the field, identify new trends and opportunities, engage relevant stakeholders, and make direct recommendations to ensure an appropriate balance of community programs, facilities and amenities now and into the future.
- ✓ Approved Resolution 21-R-75 approving the 2022 General Services Pay Plan.
- Approved, in its first reading, Ordinance 21-33 to amend the Zoning Code in order to create a new district called "Industrial/Innovation". A second reading will occur on December 20, 2021.
- Approved, in its first reading, Ordinance 21-34 a city-initiated rezoning of 470 acres of land generally located west of Airport Access Road to the western city limits from Agriculture, Highway Business, and Office/Industrial Park to "Industrial/Innovation". A second reading will occur on December 20, 2021.
- Approved, as an emergency, Ordinance 21-31 authorizing appropriations for fiscal year 2022.
- Approved, as an emergency, Ordinance 21-32 authorizing the extension of a moratorium on zoning approvals for the properties west of the Airport Access Road until January 21, 2022.
