

Vandalia City Council meeting of Monday, November 15, 2021



Council Action

In an effort to increase awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the actions of the Vandalia City Council. We hope this promotes a better understanding of the role Council plays in keeping Vandalia a great place to live, work and play.

Council took the following actions at the Monday, November 15 meeting:

- ✔ Approved Resolution 21-R-69 awarding the bid for the Gabriel Street Reconstruction Project to Sturm Construction, Inc. at the lowest bid price of \$739,492. A portion of this project will be funded through the Ohio Public Works Commission in the amount of \$398,832, with 50% being a grant and 50% being a no interest loan. We anticipate a start date for this project in Spring 2022.
- ✔ Approved Resolution 21-R-70 adopting 2022 City Wide Policy Goals. The policy goals can be viewed here: <https://www.vandaliaohio.org/453/2022-Citywide-Policy-Goals>
- ✔ Approved, as an emergency, Ordinance 21-30 assessing properties for delinquent accounts related to storm water fees, trash collection, weed cutting, sewer and water.
- ✔ Approved a variance for 6161 Ventnor Avenue to permit an increase in outdoor storage from 25% of the building's principal floor area to 89%.
