

In an effort to increase awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the actions of the Vandalia City Council. We hope this promotes a better understanding of the role Council plays in keeping Vandalia a great place to live, work and play.

Council took the following actions at the Monday, November 15 meeting:

- Approved Resolution 21-R-69 awarding the bid for the Gabriel Street Reconstruction Project to Sturm Construction, Inc. at the lowest bid price of \$739,492. A portion of this project will be funded through the Ohio Public Works Commission in the amount of \$398,832, with 50% being a grant and 50% being a no interest loan. We anticipate a start date for this project in Spring 2022.
- Approved Resolution 21-R-70 adopting 2022 City Wide Policy Goals. The policy goals can be viewed here: https://www.vandaliaohio.org/453/2022-Citywide-Policy-Goals
- Approved, as an emergency, Ordinance 21-30 assessing properties for delinquent accounts related to storm water fees, trash collection, weed cutting, sewer and water.
- ✓ Approved a variance for 6161 Ventnor Avenue to permit an increase in outdoor storage from 25% of the building's principal floor area to 89%.
