

In an effort to increase awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the actions of the Vandalia City Council. We hope this promotes a better understanding of the role Council plays in keeping Vandalia a great place to live, work and play.

Council took the following actions at the Monday, September 19 meeting:

- Approved, as an emergency, Ordinance 22-36 for a temporary advance and reimbursement between the General Fund to the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Fund for partial payment of expenses related to the Parks and Recreation Playground Equipment Project.
- Approved, as an emergency, Ordinance 22-39 authorizing a temporary advance and reimbursement between the General Fund to the FEMA Special Revenue Fund for partial payment of expenses related to the replacement of the self-contained breathing apparatus project.
- Approved, as an emergency, Ordinance 22-37 authorizing the assessment of properties for delinquent accounts related to stormwater fees, trash collection, delinquent sewer & water, and weed cutting.
- Approved Resolution 22-R-62 to waive formal bidding and authorize the purchase of playground equipment for the Vandalia Sports Complex (baseball playground units) and Helke Park through the State of Ohio Procurement program from Landscape Structures at a cost not to exceed \$700,000. The following funds are available for the Playground Replacement Project:
 - o Sports Complex \$375,000 \$225,000 ARPA Funds \$150,000 CIP Funds
 - o Helke Park \$325,000 \$225,000 ARPA Funds \$100,000 CDBG Funds
- Approved Resolution 22-R-67 accepting the 2022 Assistance to Firefighters Grant Award. The Division of Fire was awarded this grant to assist us in replacing our self-contained breathing apparatus. The award is for \$225,567 and the City's match is \$11,278.36.
- ▼ Tabled Ordinance 22-35 in its second reading. This ordinance would amend the Vandalia Codified Ordinance sections 1042.11, 1044.06 (d), and 1045.28 regarding water, sewer, waste water treatment and storm water drainage rates. This ordinance was tabled until the October 3, 2022 meeting.
- Approved a variance to allow a second curb opening on the same street frontage at 769 Center Drive.
- Machine Approved a variance to allow a 4-foot-tall woven wire fence on property located at 9005 Dog Leg Road.
