

In an effort to increase awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the actions of the Vandalia City Council. We hope this promotes a better understanding of the role Council plays in keeping Vandalia a great place to live, work and play.

Council took the following actions at the Monday, October 17, 2022, meeting:

- Approved Resolution 22-R-70 authorizing the purchase of an Asphalt Hot Box & Recycler from the McLean Company at the contract price of \$45,384. The Hot Box will allow the Public Works Division to make permanent pothole repairs during the winter months.
- Approved Resolution 22-R-71 authorizing a formal agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) to oversee and manage a project to install a signal at the intersection of Northwoods Boulevard and I-75 southbound ramps. The City will be responsible for 26% of the estimated costs including engineering. The Ohio Jobs and Commerce Department is contributing \$80,000 toward this project.
- Approved Resolution 22-R-72 establishing Council's summer meeting schedule. During the months of June, July, and August 2023, Council will meet once per month on the 3rd Monday of each month. Council's workshop would begin at 6 p.m. and the Council meeting at 7:00 p.m.
- Approved Resolution 22-R-73 waiving formal bidding and authorizing the City Manager to purchase three 2023 Ford Utility police patrol vehicles from Statewide Ford Lincoln in Van Wert, Ohio at a purchase price of \$49,482 per unit for a total cost of \$148,446.
- Approved, in its second reading, Ordinance 22-35 amending the Vandalia Codified Ordinance sections 1042.11, 1044.06(D), and 1045.28 regarding water, sewer, wastewater treatment, and stormwater drainage rates. Adjusting these rates will ensure adequate funds are available to meet regulatory mandates, and needs relating to operating, maintenance, and capital projects.
- Approved, as an emergency, Ordinance 22-40 assessing properties for delinquent accounts related to storm water fees, trash collection, delinquent water & sewer, and weed cutting.
- Approved a variance to allow outdoor storage at 118% of the principal building's footprint on property located at 3345 Stop Eight Road with one condition.
