

Council Action

In an effort to increase awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the actions of the Vandalia City Council. We hope this promotes a better understanding of the role Council plays in keeping Vandalia a great place to live, work and play.

Council took the following actions at the Monday, November 7, 2022, meeting:

- ✔ Mayor Herbst presented a proclamation recognizing the Suther & Krimm Family Airline Dairy Crème for their 60-year commitment to the Vandalia community.
- ✔ Approved Resolution 22-R-74 authorizing the replacement of ballfield fencing, including outfield, backstop and dug-out fencing, on field #11 at the Sports Complex for \$38,670.
- ✔ Approved Resolution 22-R-75 authorizing an exterior maintenance project for the Municipal Building at a cost of \$33,860.
- ✔ Approved Resolution 22-R-76 amending the Façade Improvement Program. These amendments expand the program Citywide and clarify that any renovations comply with the City's adopted plans.
- ✔ Approved Resolution 22-R-77 authorizing a request for reimbursement from the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) for the Gabriel Street Reconstruction Project. This \$398,832 project received a grant for \$199,416 and \$199,416 in a zero-percent interest loan.
- ✔ Approved Resolution 22-R-78 authorizing a one-year agreement with SwimSafe Pool Management for aquatic staffing services at a total cost of \$504,000.
- ✔ Approved Resolution 22-R-79 authorizing the purchase of an unmarked vehicle for the Criminal Investigation Section from Beau Townsend Ford for \$40,745. An additional \$2,975.60 was authorized to equip the vehicle with the necessary equipment for operations.
- ✔ Approved, in its first reading, Ordinance 22-41 updating user fees for Cassel Hills Golf Course.
- ✔ Approved, in its first reading, Ordinance 22-42 authorizing budget appropriations for FY 2023.
