

In an effort to increase awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the actions of the Vandalia City Council. We hope this promotes a better understanding of the role Council plays in keeping Vandalia a great place to live, work and play.

## Council took the following actions at the Monday, November 21, 2022, meeting:

- ₩ Approved Resolution 22-R-80 authorizing a 2% increase to the General Services Pay Plan pay grades.
- ₩ Approved Resolution 22-R-81 authorizing a 2% increase to the Part-time Pay Plan.
- Approved Resolution 22-R-82 authorizing the purchase of water meters with Badger E-Series Ultrasonic Meters and appurtenances at a cost of \$445,000. The current water meters have exceeded their useful life. Once installed, utility customers will be able to access their account through an app to track their usage and/or be alerted to any potential leaks.
- Approved Resolution 22-R-83 authorizing the City Manager to enter into a lease renewal for the storage of certain City property.
- ✓ Approved, in its second reading, Ordinance 22-41 updating user fees for Cassel Hills Golf Course.
- Approved, as an emergency in its second reading, Ordinance 22-42 authorizing budget appropriations for FY 2023.
- Approved, as an emergency, Ordinance 22-43 assessing properties for delinquent accounts related to stormwater fees, trash collection, delinquent water & sewer, and weed cutting.
- Approved a Conditional Use Permit to permit an animal boarding facility with an outdoor run/play area at 165 N. Dixie Drive with certain conditions.
- Tabled a variance request relating to solar panels at 825 Olde Farm Court until March 6, 2023.
