

In an effort to increase awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the actions of the Vandalia City Council. We hope this promotes a better understanding of the role Council plays in keeping Vandalia a great place to live, work and play.

Council took the following actions at the Monday, December 5, 2022, meeting:

- ₩ Approved Resolution 22-R-84 adopting the 2023 City Wide Policy Goals.
- Approved Resolution 22-R-85 authorizing the City Manager to contract with Technical Choice, LLC. for a project design agreement to perform a detailed golf irrigation design for Cassel Hills Golf Course for \$63,950.
- Approved Resolution 22-R-86 authorizing the purchase of a 2023 Pick Up Truck with Plow Package from Beau Townsend Ford at a purchase price of \$62,585. A 2000 Ford Truck and 2005 Ford Passenger Van will be traded in for \$4,500 bringing the total purchase price to \$58,085.
- Approved Resolution 22-R-87 waiving the bidding and authorizing the purchased and installation of playground safety surface from Forever Lawn of Ohio at a cost not to exceed \$275,000. The safety surface will be placed under the new playground equipment at the Sports Complex and Helke Park.
- Approved Resolution 22-R-88 approving an annual service maintenance agreement with Motorola Solutions to provide maintenance for the Spillman Software program at a cost of \$52,965. This software package includes Computer-Aided Dispatch, Records Management System, and mobile report writing.
- Approved, in its first reading, Ordinance 22-44 considering a request to rezone property at 7249 N. Dixie Drive from Highway Business to Industrial.
