

In an effort to increase awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the actions of the Vandalia City Council. We hope this promotes a better understanding of the role Council plays in keeping Vandalia a great place to live, work and play.

## Council took the following actions at the Monday, April 17, 2023, meeting:

- Mayor Herbst presented a proclamation to the Bicycle Advisory Committee recognizing the month of May as Bicycling Month in the City of Vandalia.
- Approved Resolution 23-R-27 awarding the bid for the City's annual concrete project to Finfrock Construction Company, Inc. as the lowest and best bid of \$474,000.
- Approved Resolution 23-R-28 authorizing an increase to the Part-Time Pay Plan ranges by an additional 1% above the current rate.
- Approved Resolution 23-R-29 authorizing an increase to the General Services Pay Plan ranges by an additional 1% above the current rate.
- Approved Resolution 23-R-30 authorizing the purchase of a 2023 Ford F-150 XL hybrid pick-up truck from Beau Townsend Ford in the amount of \$51,215 for the Vandalia Division of Police.
- Approved, in its first reading, Ordinance 23-08 amending the City's Planning & Zoning Code to refine regulations on Solar Energy Systems.
- Approved, as an emergency, Ordinance 23-09 assessing properties for delinquent accounts related to storm water fees, trash collection, delinquent sewer & water, and weed cutting.
- ₩ Approved a variance request to allow a fence in the front yard at 1010 Industrial Park Drive with conditions.
