

In an effort to increase awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the actions of the Vandalia City Council. We hope this promotes a better understanding of the role Council plays in keeping Vandalia a great place to live, work and play.

Council took the following actions at the Monday, September 18, 2023, meeting:

- ✓ City Manager Wendt gave the Oath of Office to Fire Marshal Scott Jacobs. Mr. Jacobs was promoted on September 8.
- W Chris Franzmann of Squire, Patton, & Boggs LLP presented on public finance debt limitations.
- Approved Resolution 23-R-59 authorizing an agreement with AP Triton to conduct a Community Risk Assessment for the Vandalia Division of Fire. The Division of Fire received a \$23,071.43 grant. The City's match/contribution will be \$32,101.57.
- Approved Resolution 23-R-60 authorizing a master services agreement with WDG Group LLC for Phase One Engineering and Design for the Public Works Facility in an amount up to \$125,000.
- Approved Resolution 23-R-61 authorizing a two-year agreement with SwimSafe Pool Management for aquatic staffing services at Cassel Hills Pool and the Vandalia Recreation Center.
- ₩ Approved, as an emergency, Ordinance 23-23 authorizing supplemental appropriations to the 2023 Budget.
