

In an effort to increase awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the actions of the Vandalia City Council. We hope this promotes a better understanding of the role Council plays in keeping Vandalia a great place to live, work and play.

Council took the following actions at the Monday, October 2, 2023, meeting:

- Waived a hearing regarding a liquor permit application for Family Dollar at 670 W. National Road.
- ✓ Approved Resolution 23-R-62 adopting the Part-Time Play Plan for 2024.
- ₩ Approved Resolution 23-R-63 adopting the General Services Pay Plan for 2024.
- Approved Resolution 23-R-64 waiving formal bidding and authorizing the emergency purchase and installation of a new sanitary and storm water pumping system for the Municipal Building from Heeter Plumbing for \$34,441.
- Approved, in its first reading, Ordinance 23-24 to create a Fire Insurance Fund, a related policy, and codifying the same. This Ordinance would allow the City of Vandalia to obtain a portion of fire insurance proceeds when there is a major loss, and to hold those proceeds in a fund to ensure the building is either torn down or repaired.
