## Council took the following actions at the Monday, November 20, 2023, meeting:

- Fire Marshal Scott Jacobs presented Don and Cameron Da Cunha with the Division of Fire's Civilian Medal of Honor for their heroic efforts on July 29, 2023.
- W City Manager Wendt, Director Clark and Director Cron presented Building Inspector Chris Mastrino and Facilities Superintendent Rudy Wells with the Employee of the Year award for their outstanding work on the Facilities Improvement Project.
- Chris Mackey, Community Impact and Engagement Manager of Big Brothers Big Sisters Miami Valley, gave a presentation to Council.
- W City Manager Wendt invited those in attendance to attend the City of Vandalia Christmas Tree Lighting and Holiday market on Sunday, December 3. The market will open at 4:00 p.m. in the Recreation Center Gymnasium, and the tree lighting will take place at 6:00 p.m. in the Recreation Center west parking lot.
- Approved Resolution 23-R-74 setting forth the intention to appropriate an aerial easement over certain land for public purposes.
- Approved Resolution 23-R-75, waiving competitive bidding and authorizing a continued contract with Motorola Solutions to provide maintenance and service for the Spillman software used by the Division of Police.
- Approved Resolution 23-R-76, authorizing the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the International Association of Fire Fighters.
- Approved, in its second reading, Ordinance 23-30, approving the editing and inclusion of certain ordinances and resolutions passed by Council since the last update. This update will codify all pertinent legislation passed by Council during 2022, as well as incorporate amendments to the Ohio Revised Code.
- Approved a variance to allow a fence to be constructed beyond the front building line in a nonresidential district at 3715 Wyse Road.
