# Major watermain replacement project to begin in early 2025

A major watermain replacement project is scheduled to begin work in early 2025.

The project will see the watermains replaced on Tionda Drive, Mossview Drive, and Ranchview Drive.

"These are watermains that were installed in the 1950's," said Ben Borton, Public Service Director. "As the watermains aged, they've become more prone to watermain breaks; in total we have had 61 documented watermain breaks in this project area in the past 50 years."

Repairing a watermain break requires crews to cut into the pavement to uncover the break, make the repair, and then fill the hole back in. This causes disruption of water service to the residents and diminishes firefighting resources. With new watermains in place, the occurrence of these expensive and timeconsuming repairs will be greatly diminished.

The project will include the watermains getting replaced, and each resident will get a new service line leading to the front edge of their property. The project will also have crews replacing all of the fire hydrants on the three affected streets, and completely resurfacing the roadways.

The project will cost \$1.8 million to complete. The City received a \$900,000 grant from the Ohio Public Works Commission to offset half of the project's expenses.

# A splash pad is headed to a Vandalia Park in 2025

Robinette Park will see several improvements in 2025, including the installation of a new playground and a splash pad. The improvements are part of the City's 2025 budget.

"This is something we've had many residents request over the years," said Rob Cron, Assistant City Manager. "It's very exciting to be able to move forward this year on this project."

The water feature is still in the design phase. Earlier renderings might be changed slightly in the final design.

Much of the funding for this project will come from outside sources.

"For the Robinette Park improvements, we were fortunate to receive \$400,000 in Federal funds through Congressionally-directed spending, and a one-time \$400,000 grant from the State of Ohio Strategic Fund," said Cron. The cost of the Robinette Park improvements will be \$1.2 million, which includes the cost of the restroom facility constructed in 2024.

Construction on the splash pad is expected to begin in Spring of 2025, with completion before the end of the year.

Recycle your Christmas tree

Even though we don't want to think about it right now, the Holiday Season will come to a close sometime in January. And when it comes time to put away the ornaments and take down the tree, the City of Vandalia wants you to know that you have some options on how best to dispose of the tree.

Residents who want to dispose of their Christmas tree in an environmentally responsible way will be glad to know that the City of Vandalia Tree Recycling program will be in effect beginning December 26. Residents are free to bring their Christmas Trees to the Sports Complex parking lot, where the trees will be ground into a mulch.

"This is a service the City has offered for a number of years, and people appreciate it," said Steve Clark, Director of Parks and Recreation. "The dropoff point is clearly marked, and most people are in and out of the lot in less than a couple of minutes."

The City will be accepting trees through the first two weeks of January.

# Seven-year-old hero honored

A seven-year-old Vandalia boy was honored in October for his heroic action this past summer. Nate Sevy, a 2022 graduate of the City of Vandalia Passport to Safety program, is credited with saving his greatgrandmother's life when she fell ill in July. He was presented with the City of Vandalia Civilian Heroism Award.

Sevy was spending the weekend at his great-grandmother's home and was up early when she started feeling ill. In the early morning hours, Nate checked on his great-grandmother and brought her a blanket.

"He said Grandma you're getting worse," remembered Carol Hall, Nate's great-grandmother. "I told him he needed to call his dad, and 9-1-1."

Nate called his father first to let him

know what was happening, and then dialed 9-1-1.

"I couldn't call 9-1-1," Hall said. "I felt like I was going into shock."

Dispatchers at the Vandalia Communications Center said Nate handled the call perfectly. He explained the situation and calmly answered all the dispatcher's questions. He then waited at the door to let emergency crews in when they arrived.

"These are the stories that illustrate the importance of programs like our Passport to Safety," said Vandalia Fire Chief Chad Follick. "It's very gratifying to see kids like Nate be able to use the training he received to get his great-grandmother the help she needed."

Hall summed it up best when she said, "he's my little hero."



## **Learn CPR from** new kiosk at VRC

The City of Vandalia Division of Fire is partnering with the American Heart Association and Kettering Health to offer Vandalia residents a simple and easy way to learn a life-saving medical technique. In October a hands-on CPR kiosk was placed at the Vandalia Recreation Center.

The machine offers a user-friendly tutorial that shows the user how to perform Hands-Only CPR. The kiosk includes a mechanical dummy that users can practice on and receive feedback on their technique.

With approximately 350,000 Americans experiencing sudden cardiac arrest each year-90% of whom do not survive—timely intervention is crucial.

Fire Chief Chad Follick says the Division of Fire is engaged in a multi-year initiative to educate as many people as possible on hands-only CPR, Automatic Electronic Defibrillation machines, and full CPR. Follick said all freshmen entering Vandalia-Butler High School this year will receive CPR training.

"This is a force multiplier," Follick explained. "It's extremely valuable to have trained bystanders nearby when we are 4-6 minutes away from a medical response."

The kiosk will be available for public use during regular Rec Center hours through the month of February. You do not need to be a member of the center to use the kiosk.

#### **Commemorative Tree Program**

The Commemorative Tree Program provides you with the opportunity to enhance the City with trees that commemorate your loved ones, an organization, or event. Trees serve as a living link to our past, a wonderful asset in the present, and a wise investment in our future.

The City of Vandalia cares for all City-owned trees. Commemorative Trees planted on City property are included in the City's tree maintenance program, which includes pruning, mulching, and fertilizing. Trees will be watered at the time of planting and during drought stress conditions during the first year of establishment. The City will transplant or replace any Commemorative Tree threatened by land use or site changes during the lifetime of the tree.

All participants receive a Commemorative Tree Recognition Certificate, and the donation will be recognized on a brass nameplate which will be attached to an attractive indoor plague located at the Municipal Building or Vandalia Recreation Center (your choice). To place recognition at the tree, the City of Vandalia offers the additional options of either a Commemorative Tree Charm, or a Commemorative Plaque. 



## **Vandalia Police Chief Althouse** honored with Patriot Award



Vandalia Police Chief Kurt Althouse was honored in September by Homeland Security for his volunteer service to the Montgomery County Law Enforcement Memorial in Dayton.

In a ceremony held at the Ohio State Highway Patrol Academy in September, Chief Althouse was given The Patriot Award. The award is bestowed on military and public safety personnel who have provided exceptional service to protect and serve their community and country.

Chief Althouse was nominated and received the Patriot Award for his dedicated service with the Montgomery County Law

Enforcement Officer Memorial in Dayton. As one of the founding members of the non-profit organization in 2006, Chief Althouse has been instrumental in establishing and organizing an annual ceremony that honors the fallen officers from agencies across Montgomery County. Each year on the first Friday of May, police agencies and community leaders gather at Riverscape to recognize and honor the 48 law enforcement officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty while serving their communities across Montgomery County.

The ceremony is a moving event where the families and colleagues of fallen officers pay respects to our fallen officers and have a roll call of each officer's name, agency, and their end of watch date memorialized by the pinning of a carnation in a memorial wreath.

Additionally, scholarships are awarded to the children of fallen officers or officers who serve in agencies across Montgomery County. Over the past 17 years, over \$30,000 in scholarships have been awarded to the children of officers to support their pursuit of higher education.

Currently, the Montgomery County Officer Memorial Foundation is breaking ground and fundraising for a new permanent officer memorial in downtown Dayton near the Masonic Center where the names of the fallen officers of Montgomery County agencies will be engraved and honored at the permanent memorial.
