

2025 Road Resurfacing

The list of roads that will be resurfaced in 2025 has been released.

In all, contractors will cover 137,797 square yards of roadway to resurface 33 streets.

The plan calls for all concrete work to be done first, which will entail repairing curbs and drive approaches. Wheelchair-accessible curbs will also be installed at each corner of the streets to be resurfaced.

Concrete work will begin in the spring. The entire resurfacing project should be completed by mid-summer.

The resurfacing project is funded primarily through a congressionally directed funding grant from U.S. Rep. Mike Turner through the U.S. Housing and Urban Development and the City of Vandalia Safe and Stable Levy. Homeowners will not be assessed for any of the work.

New Irrigation System at Cassel Hills Golf Course

Golfers at Cassel Hills Golf Course will be sharing the course this summer with contractors installing a new irrigation system. The new system will replace the original irrigation system installed more than 50 years ago.

Contractors have already begun staging materials for the project, which is expected to begin in June. Once work begins, contractors will shut down one hole at a time as they install the new lines. Golfers will be asked to skip the hole under construction, making the course a 17-hole venue for much of the year. Cassel Hills staff will keep golfers informed as to which hole will be closed on a given day.

"Closing a hole at a time is the best way to get the work done while minimizing the impact on play," said Steve Clark, Vandalia Parks and Recreation Director. "There will be a fee adjustment on days when only 17 holes are available."

Clark says the project is long overdue, as crews are having a difficult time keeping the current irrigation system operational.

"The existing system is so old that it's become almost impossible to get replacement parts," said Director Clark. "Our guys have had to be very creative in finding solutions when something goes down, it's been challenging to keep it going."

The new irrigation system features a double-row setup, meaning two irrigation lines will be installed on each hole. This will allow for more of the course to be watered.

The \$2 million system includes a new pump system and a new control station, located in the pump house.
















Location for new facility's 17-arce parcel on Northwoods Boulevard.

Larger Public Works facility to serve Vandalia

Vandalia City Council approved a resolution in January authorizing the City manager to contract with WDC Group for the architectural design and construction management of a Public Works facility.

The new facility will be constructed on a 16-acre parcel of land located just east of Kroger on Northwoods Boulevard. The land was donated to the City.

This is a very important project for Vandalia," said Rob Cron, Vandalia Assistant City Manager. "Our current facility is outdated and not big enough to meet our needs."

Currently, Vandalia's Public Works facility is located on a 4-acre site on Clubhouse Way.

"Because of the space limitations, we do not have enough space to store our vehicles under roof and away from the elements," Cron said. "We have millions of dollars of equipment that are aging prematurely because they are exposed to the elements."

City crews will access the facility from Northwoods Boulevard. There will only be a gated emergency access from the new facility to Brown School Road.

The existing facility has a limited salt storage capacity, meaning the City has to make periodic salt purchases throughout the winter months to have enough salt on hand to handle the snow and ice. "There are times when we are at the mercy of suppliers to make sure we have enough salt to make it through the winter," Cron said.

The new facility will double the capacity for salt storage and ensure there is enough on hand to handle an entire

The current 51,000 square foot facility is still in the design phase. City leaders expect a completed design to be sent out for bid in fall 2025. It is expected the new facility will be ready for occupancy in 2027.

New stage at Art Park

A new stage and a covered band shell are the latest additions to the City of Vandalia Art Park Amphitheater. In late Fall, crews began the project that saw the stage area widened, additional seating installed, and a beautiful shelter installed.

"The Art Park has grown over the years to become a destination for many residents and visitors," said Steve Clark, Parks and Recreation Director. "The enhancements to the amphitheater will allow larger crowds to enjoy music at the Art Park, and keep performers out of the elements."

The amphitheater is just one of the improvements underway at the park. Crews are in the process of creating some asphalt pads along the east edge of the park to allow food trucks to set up on the park grounds.

Brandon Sucher selected to become Vandalia's new Police Chief

Vandalia Police Captain Brandon Sucher has been selected to become the City's next police chief. Sucher will lead the department following the transition of current Police Chief Kurt Althouse to fulltime city manager.

"It was an intensive interview process for police chief," said Interim City Manager Kurt Althouse. "Brandon brings a strong skill set that meets the expectations of police chief, including a strong community focus, strategic agency goals & vision, and a desire to continue the police department's 'Tradition of Excellence".

Captain Sucher is a life-long Vandalia resident and graduate of Vandalia-Butler High School. Brandon attended Bluffton University where he played basketball and obtained his bachelor's degree in criminal justice and Sociology with a minor in Psychology. He continued his education at the University of Dayton where he completed his master's degree in public administration in 2008. Captain Sucher joined the Vandalia Division of Police in 2021 following employment with the Trotwood Police Department and Huber Heights Division of Police, where he served as patrol officer, liaison officer, and patrol sergeant. He completed Supervisor Training and Education Program (S.T.E.P.) and Police Executive Leadership College (P.E.L.C.) through the Ohio Association of Chiefs of Police. He is currently an active member of the Vandalia-Butler Optimist Club, Sister Cities of Vandalia, Vandalia Historical Society, Butler Baseball Club, and St. Christopher CYI Athletic Basketball.

Captain Sucher will become police chief on May 1st and his ceremonial Oath of Office will be administered at the May 5th Council meeting.









Vandalia Division of Police Honor Officer and Civilian **Employee of the Year**

In January the Vandalia Division of Police honored Deborah Wright as the Civilian Employee of the Year and Joe Manning as the Officer of the Year.

The selection process includes nominations from peers and a review and decision by a selection committee. These employees were selected based on several criteria including receipt of Division awards, limited or no disciplinary actions, citizen commendations, overall productivity, community involvement, supplemental duties, contributions to the Division, and a general level of professionalism as exhibited by appearance, bearing, attitude, and demeanor.

"Prior to her promotion to the Support Services Manager (SSM) in November of 2024, Deborah took an active role in the field training program for new public safety specialists (PSS)," Althouse explained. "This consistent training process placed even more demand on her as she also maintained her supplemental duties at an exceptional level and prepared for the promotional process."

Althouse said "Deborah is deserving of this award due to her exceptional actions, high performance and

productivity, no discipline, community involvement, and professionalism as demonstrated by her appearance, attitude, and demeanor."

"Additionally, her pleasant and friendly personality and warm smile brightens the office and serves as a welcome to staff and outside vendors or quests who may visit the police department," he added. "She delivers top-tier, first-class service to everyone she assists and is a fine representative of the city."

The Police Officer of the Year for 2024 is Officer Joe Manning. A 24year veteran of the Division, Manning was honored for his hard work, reliability and willingness to mentor younger officers.

"Joe has been a model of consistency and professionalism throughout his career," said Althouse. "Other employees noted that Joe is dependable, a man of integrity, and always willing to assist another officer or a citizen when needed."

Manning's nomination letter also praised him for his involvement in the apprehension of suspects involved in multiple area auto thefts and for his capture of a wanted felon hiding in a residence.

The award is a fitting send-off for Manning, who retired from the Division of Police in January.

"While it is easy to get caught up in the excitement of a pending retirement, his career has been one where he has maintained the high standards he has set for himself all the way to the end," Althouse said. "Officer Manning is a great representative for VPD and provides top-tier service to city residents that meets or exceeds Division and Citywide Policy Goals.

Vandalia seeking another aggregation agreement

The collective of local cities Vandalia joined in an electricity aggregation program will be seeking bids this summer for a new three-year agreement. The initial contract will expire at the end of the year.

In 2022, Vandalia voters overwhelmingly approved a measure to participate in a collective to achieve lower electricity and natural gas rates. The City entered the local collective with a number of neighboring communities to negotiate a lower rate.

"We worked with the Miami Valley Communications Council, The Ohio Municipal League, and Palmer Energy to put the program together with a number of surrounding communities," said Kurt Althouse, Vandalia City Manager. "Essentially aggregation is reaping the benefit of putting a bunch of buyers together to get a better price."

Approximately 2700 Vandalia households are participating in the program, and each customer have saved roughly \$350 on average in electricity costs over the past year. Small commercial customers are saving approximately \$600 per year off standard rates. Within the total of the City of Vandalia, the annual savings is roughly \$1.1 million. The expectation is that customers will see similar savings in 2025.

Vandalia City Council has authorized City staff to pursue another aggregation agreement that goes into effect when the existing agreement expires in 2025. The plan is to go out for quotes in the spring of 2025 and have a new rate plan in effect by the end of the year.

Our nonresident dual membership allows two adults (residing in same household) to belong to the VRC for \$48.50 per month. In addition, our membership rates are discounted to those employed in Vandalia city limits. A Business adult membership is priced at \$32.50 per month. We offer Military and age based discounts as well.

Members enjoy use of our gymnasium, fitness floor, indoor walking/jogging track, and aquatics center. Our climbing wall, drop-in fitness classes, and child care services are offered at additional affordable fees. We also offer pre-paid and annual unlimited passes for these features.




