RESOLUTION 20-R-65

DECLARING CERTAIN EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY AS NECESSARY DUE TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY WITH RESPECT TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 5001 OF THE FEDERAL CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT (“CARES ACT”)

The resolution, which bears the foregoing title, was unanimously adopted Monday, November 2, 2020, by the Council of the City of Vandalia. It declares certain expenditures of the city as necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19 Pandemic in compliance with the provisions of Section 5001 of the Federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, And Economic Security Act (“CARES ACT”). ORDINANCE 20-29

AN ORDINANCE TO REVISE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO DURING THE CALENDAR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2020, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE 19-24 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

The ordinance, which bears the foregoing title, was unanimously approved in an emergency reading Monday, November 2, 2020, by the Council of the City of Vandalia. It revises appropriations for current expenses and other expenditures of the City of Vandalia, Montgomery County, Ohio during the calendar year ending December 31, 2020, and amending Ordinance 19-24 and declaring an emergency. ORDINANCE 20-30

AN ORDINANCE REZONING 15 ACRES OF VACANT LAND IN THE NORTHWEST PORTION OF THE FOXFIRE SUBDIVISION FROM RESIDENTIAL SINGLE-FAMILY 2 (RSF-2) TO RESIDENTIAL SINGLE-FAMILY 4 (RSF-4) AND AMENDING THE ZONING MAP OF THE CITY

The ordinance, which bears the foregoing title was unanimously approved in its first reading Monday, November 2, 2020, by the Council of the City of Vandalia. This rezones 15 acres of vacant land in the northwest portion of the Foxfire Subdivision from Residential Single-Family 2 (RSF-2) to Residential Single-Family 4 (RSF-4) and amends the zoning map of the City. A public hearing will be held on the proposed ordinance and the ordinance will be considered for final adoption by the Council of the City of Vandalia, Ohio on Monday, November 16 at 7:00 p.m., in Council Chambers, 333 J.E. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS WITHIN THE VANDALIA ZONING CODE CHAPTERS 1212, 1214, 1216, 1218, 1220, 1224, 1226, 1232, 1234, 1236, 1240, AND 1244

AN ORDINANCE REZONING 14 PARCELS OF LAND IN THE CITY OF VANDALIA FROM PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT (PUD) TO OFFICE-RESIDENTIAL (OR), OFFICE SERVICE (OS), AND HIGHWAY BUSINESS (HB) AND AMENDING THE ZONING MAP OF THE CITY

The ordinance, which bears the foregoing title was unanimously approved in its first reading Monday, November 2, 2020, by the Council of the City of Vandalia. This rezones 14 parcels of land in the City of Vandalia from Planned Unit Development (PUD) to Office-Residential (OR), Office Service (OS), and Highway Business (HB) and amends the zoning map of the City.
