



Roll House Lanes
BOWLING COMPETITION
Event Sponsor- PSA Airlines

EVENT DESCRIPTION: Bowling Competition. Two- (2) male and two (2) female participants will make up a team to compete in the bowling competition to be held at Roll House Lanes in Huber Heights. The team with the highest number of pins accumulated during the baker format competition will win the event.

LOCATION/DATE/TIME: Roll House Lanes- Huber Heights/ Wednesday, June 4/ 6:00 p.m.

TEAM ENTRY INFORMATION: Two- (2) male and two (2) female participants will make up a team.

EQUIPMENT: Team jerseys must be worn to be eligible for bonus points. Participants may use their own equipment for this event. Shoes and bowling balls will be available for those participants who need them.

RULES AND FORMAT:

1. The bowling competition will be in a baker format. In the baker format each co-ed team of four will be playing as one. Each team will bowl a total of 5 games.
2. The Baker Format consists of a team of four with two males and two females bowling in an established order. The line-up of bowlers will be determined by each team prior to the start of the event. There are no restrictions to how the order is set (male/female) but once the order has been submitted it must stay the same for all five (5) games.
3. The first bowler will bowl the first frame of the game. The second bowler will bowl the second frame. The third bowler will bowl the third frame of the same game and so on until the team bowls a full game together.
4. The order of bowlers must stay the same throughout all 5 games of competition. (In other words, the first bowler will always follow the fourth bowler.)
5. Once a game is finished, the bowler who was due to roll next will start the following game.

6. Team may substitute players in between games only. The substitute must fill the role of the player they are replacing (ex. Substitute replaces bowler 3 and therefore takes the third spot in the order)

7. Scores will be recorded for each game. The scores of all 5 games will be tabulated for a total team score. The team with the highest number of pins accumulated from all 5 games will be declared the event winner.

8. Roll House Lanes staff will be on hand prior to the start of the event to cover any specific rules and format information.

SCORING:

1st Place Team - 35 points

2nd Place Team - 25 points

3rd Place Team - 20 points

4th Place Team - 15 points

5th Place Team - 13 points

6th Place Team - 12 points

7th Place Team - 11 points

8th Place Team - 10 points
