Following the ribbon cutting, many



attendees stayed and enjoyed a wonderful lunch buffet.

The Vandalia-Butler Foundation and Vandalia Parks & Recreation Department are hosting a Paddle-Palooza 36-hour Pickleball Marathon this coming weekend at Helke Park, beginning at noon on Friday, September 26th and ending at midnight on Saturday, September 27th.
