RESOLUTION 15-R-09

A RESOLUTION AWARDING THE BID FOR THREE POLICE PATROL VEHICLES REQUESTED BY THE DIVISION OF POLICE TO BEAU TOWNSEND FORD LINCOLN IN THE AMOUNT OF \$92,430 AS THE LOWEST AND BEST BID AND DECLARING THE EXISTING THREE POLICE PATROL VEHICLES BEING REPLACED SURPLUS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Council has received a memorandum and bid tabulation from Chief Knight recommending Council award the bid for three police patrol vehicles.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

Section 1. Council awards the bid for three police patrol vehicles to Beau Townsend Ford Lincoln in the amount of \$92,430.

Section 2. Council declares cruisers #15, #18 and #22, all 2013 Ford Interceptors, as surplus property and approves placing them on GovDeals or otherwise disposed of by the City Manager as provided by law after delivery of the new vehicles.

Section 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and in conformance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
