RESOLUTION 15-R-21

A RESOLUTION WAIVING THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCESS AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A JOHN DEERE 4052M COMPACT UTILITY TRACTOR FROM DEERE & COMPANY, AT THE STATE OF OHIO BID PRICE OF \$25,364.23 AND DECLARING THE EXISTING 2001 JOHN DEERE TRACTOR BEING REPLACED SURPLUS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Council has received a memorandum from Steve Clark, Director of Parks and Recreation, recommending Council waive the formal bidding process and authorize the purchase from the State of Ohio bid process for one compact utility tractor; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Vandalia Code section 208.02(e), Council has the authority to waive formal bidding process;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

- <u>Section 1</u>. Council waives the formal bidding process pursuant to Vandalia Code section 208.02(e)(2).
- <u>Section 2</u>. Council authorizes the City Manager to purchase a John Deere 4052M Compact Utility Tractor from Deere & Company of Carey, North Carolina at the State of Ohio bid price (CONTRACT #800261-STS515) of \$25,364.23.
- <u>Section 3</u>. Council declares the 2001 John Deere model being replaced as surplus property and approves placing them on GovDeals or otherwise disposed of by the City Manager as provided by law after delivery of the new tractor.
- <u>Section 4.</u> It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and in conformance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage. Passed this 16th day of March, 2015.
