#### **RESOLUTION 15-R-25**

# A RESOLUTION TERMINATING THE TAX COLLECTION AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF UNION AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO A NEW AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Vandalia has entered into an income tax collection agreement with the City of Union dated June 19, 2007 (the "Tax Agreement"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Tax Agreement automatically renews for additional one year terms unless terminated by either party by providing notice and following the process set forth in the Tax Agreement; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Vandalia desires to terminate the tax collection agreement prior to the automatic renewal and must send notification of termination at least 90 days prior to the effective date of termination; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Vandalia is willing to enter into a new or temporary agreement with Union substantially upon the same terms and condition as the existing contract, provided that the compensation to the City of Vandalia is adjusted pursuant to the direction previously provided to the City Manager from City Council;

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is authorized to terminate the Tax Agreement between the City of Vandalia and City of Union, pursuant to the provisions in the Tax Agreement and to take any and all necessary actions as required to terminate the City's obligations under the Tax Agreement.

**Section 2.** The City Manager is further authorized to negotiate and enter into a new tax collection agreement with the City of Union substantially upon the same terms and conditions as the current contract, provided the compensation to the City from Union in the new contract is changed to the City's calculated rate of \$26.55 per account.

<u>Section 3</u>. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and in conformance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 4**. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
