## **RESOLUTION 14-R-08**

A RESOLUTION WAIVING THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCESS AND AWARDING THE BID FOR A TORO WORKMAN HDX WITH MULTI PRO ADVANCED SPRAY SYSTEM, REQUESTED BY THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT, THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO CONTRACT #800261-STS515 TO CENTURY EQUIPMENT AT A COST OF \$34,826.82 AND REQUESTING COUNCIL DECLARE THE CURRENT 1993 TORO 3200 SPRAYER MODEL BEING REPLACED SURPLUS PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, Council has received a memorandum from Steve Clark, Director of Parks and Recreation, recommending Council waive the formal bidding process and award the bid from the State of Ohio bid process for a Toro Workman HDX with Multi Pro Advanced Spray System; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Vandalia Code section 208.02(e), Council has the authority to waive the formal bidding process;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. Council waives the formal bidding process pursuant to Vandalia Code section 208.02(e).

<u>Section 2</u>. Council awards the bid from the State of Ohio bid process for a Toro Workman HDX with Multi Pro Advanced Spray System to Century Equipment at the State bid price of \$34,826.82.

**Section 3.** Council declares the current 1993 Toro 3200 sprayer model as surplus and approves placing it on GovDeals after delivery of the new mower.

**Section 4.** This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
