RESOLUTION 14-R-08

A RESOLUTION WAIVING THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCESS AND AWARDING THE BID FOR A TORO WORKMAN HDX WITH MULTI PRO ADVANCED SPRAY SYSTEM, REQUESTED BY THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT, THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO CONTRACT #800261-ST5515 TO CENTURY EQUIPMENT AT A COST OF \$34,826.82 AND REQUESTING COUNCIL DECLARE THE CURRENT 1993 TORO 3200 SPRAYER MODEL BEING REPLACED SURPLUS PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, Council has received a memorandum from Steve Clark, Director of Parks and Recreation, recommending Council waive the formal bidding process and award the bid from the State of Ohio bid process for a Toro Workman HDX with Multi Pro Advanced Spray System; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Vandalia Code section 208.02(e), Council has the authority to waive the formal bidding process;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

Section 1. Council waives the formal bidding process pursuant to Vandalia Code section 208.02(e).

Section 2. Council awards the bid from the State of Ohio bid process for a Toro Workman HDX with Multi Pro Advanced Spray System to Century Equipment at the State bid price of \$34,826.82.

Section 3. Council declares the current 1993 Toro 3200 sprayer model as surplus and approves placing it on GovDeals after delivery of the new mower.

Section 4. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
