## **RESOLUTION 14-R-27**

A RESOLUTION WAIVING THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCESS AND AWARDING THE BID FOR THREE CRUISER IN-CAR CAMERAS, REQUESTED BY THE DIVISION OF POLICE, TO CDW-G IN THE AMOUNT OF \$14,460 AND DECLARING THE CAMERAS BEING REPLACED AS SURPLUS PROPERTY

**WHEREAS**, Council has received a memorandum from Darren Davey, IT Manager, recommending Council waive the formal bidding process and award the bid for three Panasonic cruiser in-car cameras as a third-party beneficiary under a state procurement contract; and

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to maintain consistency, centralized management and IT Department support, with such equipment; and

**WHEREAS,** CDW-G is the registered and authorized Panasonic reseller for this project, through the competitively bid Ohio State Term Schedule Contract; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Vandalia Code section 208.02(e), Council has the authority to waive the formal bidding process;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

- <u>Section 1</u>. Council waives the formal bidding process pursuant to Vandalia Code section 208.02(e).
  - <u>Section 2</u>. Council awards the bid for three Panasonic in-car cameras requested by the Division of Police, through the state bid from CDW-G in the amount of \$14,460.00.
  - <u>Section 3</u>. Council awards the bid and authorizes the City Manager to execute any and all documents necessary and proper to finalize the transaction.
- <u>Section 4.</u> Council declares the cameras being replaced as surplus property and approves be placed on GovDeals or otherwise disposed of by the City manager as provided by law after delivery of the new cameras.
  - <u>Section 5</u>. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
