RESOLUTION 14-R-32

A RESOLUTION WAIVING THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCESS AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF THREE STRYKER POWER PRO STRETCHERS, REQUESTED BY THE DIVISION OF FIRE, FROM STRYKER EMS EQUIPMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$44,745.06 AND DECLARING THE STRETCHERS BEING REPLACED AS SURPLUS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Council has received a memorandum from Chad Follick, Fire Chief, recommending Council waive the formal bidding process and award the bid for three Stryker Power Pro lift-assisted stretchers to Stryker EMS Equipment; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Vandalia Code section 208.02(e), Council has the authority to waive the formal bidding process;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. For the reasons set forth in the April 21, 2014 memorandum from Chad Follick to the City Manager, Council waives the formal bidding process pursuant to Vandalia Code section 208.02(e)(5).

<u>Section 2</u>. Council authorizes the purchase of three Stryker Power Pro lift-assisted stretchers requested by the Division of Fire, from Stryker EMS Equipment in the amount of \$44,745.06, which after the application of the grant awarded to the City for such purchase from the Bureau of Workman's Compensation will require the City to pay \$11,186.26.

<u>Section 3</u>. The City Manager is authorized to execute any and all documents necessary and proper to finalize the transaction authorized by this Resolution.

<u>Section 4.</u> Council declares the stretchers being replaced as surplus property and approves them being placed on GovDeals or otherwise disposed of by the City manager as provided by law after delivery of the new stretchers.

<u>Section 5</u>. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
