## **RESOLUTION 14-R-37**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT/GOVERNMENT EQUITY (ED/GE) AGREEMENT WITH MONTGOMERY COUNTY OFFICE OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, FOR THE INTEGRATED PROCUREMENT TECHNOLOGIES (IPT) PROJECT AND TO ENTER INTO AN ACCOMPANYING ED/GE AGREEMENT WITH IPT

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Vandalia has determined that it is in the best interest of the city to obtain and offer ED/GE grants to promote economic development in the City of Vandalia; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Montgomery County approved the funding in the amount of \$25,000.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the City needs to enter into a separate agreement with the Montgomery County Office of Economic Development and a separate agreement with IPT, the grant recipient with respect to the ED/GE funds; and

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

- <u>Section 1</u>. A proposed ED/GE Agreement between the City of Vandalia and Montgomery County Office of Economic Development, for the IPT Expansion Project, substantially in the form of the County's standard ED/GE contract, a copy of which is available for inspection in the Clerk of Council's office, is hereby approved.
- <u>Section 2</u>. A corresponding proposed ED/GE Agreement between the City of Vandalia and IPT, the recipient, substantially in the form of the standard City ED/GE contract, a copy of which is available for inspection in the Clerk of Council's office, is hereby approved.
- <u>Section 3</u>. Jon Crusey, City Manager, is hereby authorized to enter into agreements with Montgomery County Office of Economic Development and with IPT, or its nominee, substantially in the form and terms as contained in the above referenced proposed agreements.
