RESOLUTION 13-R-04

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE WAIVING THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCESS AND AWARDING THE BID FOR A TORO GROUNDSMASTER 3500-D, REQUESTED BY THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT, THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO CONTRACT #800261-STS515 TO CENTURY EQUIPMENT OF HAMILTON AT A COST OF \$31,903.32 AND REQUESTING COUNCIL DECLARE THE CURRENT 2002 TORO MODEL BEING REPLACED SURPLUS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Council has received a memorandum and bid tabulation from Steve Clark recommending Council waive the formal bidding process and award the bid from the State of Ohio bid process for a Toro Groundsmaster 3500-D; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Vandalia Code section 208.02(e), Council has the authority to waive formal bidding process; and

WHEREAS, at the January 7, 2013 Council meeting council approved the waiving of the bid and award of the contract, by the unanimous affirmative vote of council but did not do so in the form of a Resolution;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. Council ratifies the waiver of the formal bidding process pursuant to Vandalia Code section 208.02(e).

<u>Section 2</u>. Council ratifies its awarding the bid from the State of Ohio bid process for a Toro Groundsmaster 3500-D trim mower to Century Equipment of Hamilton at the best bid price of \$31,903.32.

<u>Section 3</u>. Council ratifies its declaration of the current 2002 Toro model as surplus and approves placing it on GovDeals after delivery of the new mower.

<u>Section 4</u>. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
