A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH VANDALIA-BUTLER BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR JOINT FACILITY USE

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Vandalia has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to enter into an agreement with Vandalia-Butler Board of Education for Joint Facility Use.

WHEREAS, The City is the owner of various real estate and facilities throughout the City, which are more particularly described in said agreement and the School Board desires to utilize such City property for school related activities, as set forth in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the School Board is the owner of various real estate and facilities throughout the City, which are more particularly described in said Agreement and the City desires to utilize such School Board City property, for City related activities, as set forth in The Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the parties acknowledge that the respective use of each other's property as described in the agreement promotes community pride and involvement, and provides economic savings to each party, and is therefore in the public interest; and

WHEREAS, the School Board has authorized the execution of the agreement by action of the School Board taken at the work session on April 3, 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. The city manager is authorized to negotiate and enter into an agreement between the City of Vandalia and Vandalia-Butler Board of Education for Joint Facility Use, substantially upon the terms and conditions contained in the proposed Agreement. The Agreement is available for inspection in the Clerk of Council's office.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect at the earliest time provide by law.
