RESOLUTION 12-R-24

**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF FULLY REINSTATING
THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT FUND**

WHEREAS, the Governor and General Assembly as part of efforts to eliminate the State of Ohio's budget deficit cut by half the amount of Local Government Funds to local governments and school districts; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio's budget deficit has been eliminated; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio's tax revenues are trending ahead of projection by nearly one billion dollars; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio's emergency "rainy day" fund now exceeds one-quarter billion dollars; and

WHEREAS, the cost cutting and efficiency measures taken by local governments and schools has disproportionately served to help return the State of Ohio to solvency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

Section 1. The Council of the City of Vandalia urges all members of the General Assembly and Governor John Kasaich to support legislation that will restore full funding of the Local Government Fund in the next bi-ennium budget.

Section 2. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
