### **ORDINANCE NO. 14-11**

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1276.24 OF THE VANDALIA ZONING CODE

**WHEREAS**, staff has determined that clarification was needed with respect to what the City considers a hard surface under its zoning code and has proposed amendments to the zoning code to provide consistency; and

**WHEREAS**, staff has recommended amending the provisions dealing with hard surfaces in Section 1276.24(c); and

**WHEREAS**, staff has also identified a need to clarify the difference between consecutive days and total days during a year as it relates to the number of days portable storage units are permitted as provided in section 1276.24; and

**WHEREAS**, Planning Commission has reviewed the proposed changes and has recommended approval of the amendments; and

**WHEREAS**, it is determined by the Council of the City of Vandalia that the amendments would be in the best interest of the citizens of Vandalia.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. Sections (c)(1)(B)(1) and (c)(1)(C)(1) of Section 1276.24, Portable Storage Units, General Regulations, Location and timeframe, is hereby amended to read as follows:

### 1276.24 PORTABLE STORAGE UNITS

- B. Moving and relocating in residential single family districts.
  - 1. When the occupant of a property is moving or relocating, a portable storage unit shall be located on a hard-surface (meaning a surface paved with concrete, asphaltic concrete or other hard surface not gravel), on the property for a period of not more than seven consecutive days, not to exceed a period of fourteen total days in any 365 day period.
- C. Other temporary uses.
  - 1. When necessary to facilitate general temporary uses not described above a portable storage unit shall be located on a hard-surface (paved with concrete, asphaltic concrete or other hard surface not gravel), on the property for a period of not more than seven

**consecutive** days, **not to exceed** a period of fourteen total days in any 365 day period.

Section 2. All other provisions of Section 1276.24 shall remain in full force and effect.

 $\underline{\textbf{Section 3}}.$  The Codified Ordinances of the City of Vandalia are hereby amended to reflect the aforementioned amendments.

<u>Section 4</u>. This Ordinance shall take full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
