**ORDINANCE 14-16**

**AN ORDINANCE TO REVISE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO DURING THE CALENDAR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2014, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE 13-17 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:**

**Section 1.** The following sums be and they are hereby increased or (reduced) as follows:

| Water Fund                    | \$15,735  |
| Sewer Fund                    | \$15,735  |

**Section 2.** The Director of Finance for the City is authorized to draw warrants on the City Treasury for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers, provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except the person employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance.

**Section 3.** The following sums be and they are hereby recognized as additional or (reduced) 2014 revenue:

**Section 4.** Ordinance 13-17 providing for annual appropriations being inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, the same is hereby amended.

**Section 5.** This legislation involves appropriating money and is hereby passed as an emergency measure pursuant to Charter Section 4-7 as being necessary in order to provide for the continued protection of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary to keep the city's financial records complete and accurate.

**Section 6.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
