## **ORDINANCE 13-15**

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A MAJOR AMENDMENT TO THE PUD FOR THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 80 CLUBHOUSE WAY AND OWNED BY RALPH AND SUSAN STODD, KNOWN AS "THE FALLS" SUBDIVISION, SECTION 6

**WHEREAS**, the property known as "The Falls" Subdivision, Section 6; specifically, located at 80 Clubhouse Way, was approved as a PUD Amendment by Council on October 25, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, the owner has requested to allow the installation of two non-conforming fences: one 8 foot fence along the north side of the property and one 6 foot fence along the south side of the property, per Section 1276.02A and 1276.02B; and

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission has held a public hearing and recommends approval of the Major Amendment to the PUD to allow the installation the 8 foot fence along the north side of the property and the 6 foot cedar fence along the south side of the property with the conditions listed in the sections below.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

**Section 1.** The major amendment is approved to allow two non-conforming fences, being the 8 foot stone fence along the north side of the property, as well as the 6 foot cedar fence along the south side of the property

**Section 2**. Plans must be submitted showing adequate landscaping in front of the stone wall. The plans must include a combination of 1 foot earthen mound, 4 foot trees and shrubs that will serve as a buffer between the front yard and stone fence. The landscaping plan must adhere to the standards set forth in Chapter 1278 in the zoning code.

**Section 3**. The cedar fence shall be built as a dual-faced fence, so that fence posts will not be exposed.

Section 4. The fence shall not be constructed within 3 feet from the right-of-way line.

<u>Section 5.</u> This ordinance shall take full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
