AN ORDINANCE TO REVISE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO DURING THE CALENDAR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2011, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE 10-14 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. The following sums be and they are hereby increased or (reduced) as follows:

General Fund	\$ 30,000
Street Fund	\$ 75,000
Permissive Tax Fund	\$ 25,000
Computer Legal Research Fund	\$ 9,000
Capital Improvement Fund	\$ 9,160
Police/Fire/Street CIP Fund	\$ 25,000
Capital Improvement Reserve	\$ 200,000

Section 2. The Director of Finance for the City is authorized to draw warrants on the City Treasury for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers, provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except the person employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance.

Section 3. The following sums be and they are hereby recognized as additional or (reduced) 2011 revenue:

General Fund	\$ 915,200
Capital Improvements Fund	\$ 326,750
Police/Fire/Street CIP Fund	\$ 112,500
