**ORDINANCE 11-07**

**AN ORDINANCE TO REVISE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO DURING THE CALENDAR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2011, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE 10-14 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:**

**Section 1.** The following sums be and they are hereby increased or (reduced) as follows:

| Permissive Tax Fund          | \$ 25,000  |
| Computer Legal Research Fund | \$ 9,000   |
| Capital Improvement Fund     | \$ 9,160   |
| Police/Fire/Street CIP Fund  | \$ 25,000  |
| Capital Improvement Reserve  | \$ 200,000 |

**Section 2.** The Director of Finance for the City is authorized to draw warrants on the City Treasury for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers, provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except the person employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance.

**Section 3.** The following sums be and they are hereby recognized as additional or (reduced) 2011 revenue:

**Section 4.** Ordinance 10-14 providing for annual appropriations being inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, the same is hereby amended.

**Section 5.** This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Vandalia and for the further reason that it is necessary to keep the city's financial records complete and accurate; therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by Council.
