ORDINANCE 11-11

AN ORDINANCE TO REVISE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO DURING THE CALENDAR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2011, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE 10-14 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. The following sums be and they are hereby increased or (reduced) as follows:

General Fund	\$ 32,000
Capital Improvement Fund	\$ 18,000
TIF Capital Projects Fund	\$ 90,000

<u>Section 2</u>. The Director of Finance for the City is authorized to draw warrants on the City Treasury for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers, provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except the person employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance.

Section 3. The following sums be and they are hereby recognized as additional or (reduced) 2011 revenue:

General Fund	\$ (191,955)
Capital Improvements Fund	\$ 341,802

Section 4. Ordinance 10-14 providing for annual appropriations being inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, the same is hereby amended.

<u>Section 5</u>. This legislation involves appropriating money and is hereby passed as an emergency measure pursuant to Charter Section 4-7 as being necessary in order to provide for the continued protection of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Vandalia and for the further reason that it is necessary to keep the city's financial records complete and accurate; therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by Council.
