

Vandalia Art Park Mosaics Project

The Public Art in Vandalia (PAIV) Program is seeking artistic volunteers for a Winter/Spring art project to produce two tile Mosaic Totems that will be displayed at the entrance to the Vandalia Art Park.



Area residents 16 and older (or younger if working with an adult) are invited to participate by designing and assembling one of 20 mosaic cylinders that will be stacked into totems. Similar projects may be viewed by searching online for images of “mosaic totems.”

Each piece will require a design of 12” x 25.13”. Volunteers will meet as a group in an open studio setting on the lower level of the Vandalia Municipal Building each Wednesday, 6 to 8 p.m., Feb. 18 to approximately April 15. PAIV Committee members and other volunteers will be on premises to provide advice and guidance on design and application. All supplies will be provided and there is no cost to participate.

Design work will begin during the first open studio session Feb. 18. Application of tiles will begin the first week of March, with the project scheduled for completion April 15. Regular attendance will be encouraged to assure the project’s success and on-time completion.

Volunteer to assist in creating these permanent art pieces for our community by completing the “Art Park Mosaics” registration form available on the Vandalia website, www.vandaliaohio.org, and submitting it to the Receptionist’s Desk at the Vandalia Municipal Building, 333 James Bohanan Drive, or by e-mail to cfarst@vandaliaohio.org. Registration deadline is Monday, Feb. 16, 5 p.m. Up to 20 volunteers will be accepted in order of registration, though City of Vandalia residents will be given registration priority.
