## **TEAM SONG/CHEER**

### **2019 NEW OPTIONS!!!!**

**EVENT DESCRIPTION:** Teams participating in this optional activity will receive bonus points toward their team's total score if they meet the specifications listed in the rules section.

**LOCATION/DATE/TIME:** Options:

1. Sports Complex baseball concession area / Friday, June 7 / Between 7-9pm. This option is what we have been doing for years.
2. Sing/perform on any given day (June 2-7). A performance could include singing the National Anthem prior to the start of the scheduled events. Performances must be approved by Jeff at least one day in advance.

**EQUIPMENT:** Team jerseys or costume must be worn to be eligible for bonus points. VPRD will provide a P.A. System and each team will be responsible for providing all other equipment needed.

#### **RULES:**

1. Teams must perform a song, cheer or performance of some sort, which symbolizes the spirit of their company and/or Corporate Challenge. You do not have to symbolize the spirit of your company or Corporate Challenge if you choose to sing the National Anthem.
2. Each song, cheer or performance is limited to a duration of one (1) minute minimum and three (3) minute max.
3. The song/cheer can be original or based on previously recorded music. Karaoke style is permitted.
4. Any number of team members can participate.
5. The name of your company must be incorporated into the song/cheer. If you are singing the National Anthem or any song that demands respect, then you are not required to incorporate your company name into the song.
6. Teams meeting the requirements in #1-5 will receive **50 points** towards their team total.
  - a. If a team misses one (1) of the requirements, they will receive 25 points.
  - b. If a team misses two (2) of the requirements, they will receive 10 points.
  - c. If a team misses three (3) or more requirements, it will result in zero (0) bonus points.
7. Take pride in your team song/cheer - Please do not use any profanity. If you are unsure about what may be considered inappropriate please contact the Jeff.
